Siblings

A 10% remission of fees is available for third and subsequent children subject to the simultaneity of all children being in the school at the same time.

Armed Forces Families

An Immediate 20% discount for day pupils from Reception to Year 3 – if one or both parents are serving then day children will receive an immediate 20% discount on fees.

CEA families will never pay more than 10% of fees - CEA can be complex, but what you pay isn't. Port Regis has one of the most generous Armed Forces schemes of any Prep School. We offer a fixed and transparent fee to CEA parents who will only ever pay 10% of our fees, with the school providing a bursary for any shortfall in CEA contribution.

What this means in the simplest terms, is that your children can experience all the magic of Port Regis for no more than £3,105 for the entire 2022-23 academic year.

Bursaries

The Governors of Port Regis are committed to broadening access to the school by offering meanstested financial support with school fees to eligible parents. This support is known as a Bursarial Award and such an award may be offered to parents of children who give evidence of above-average ability or potential in various areas of school life. Bursarial Awards may be awarded in the form of a remission of up to 50% on fees payable, depending on the financial, compassionate or other pertinent circumstances of applicants. Children who are given an award for potential, but whose parents have sufficient means to pay full fees, will receive a notional financial award in recognition of their achievement.

In order to meet the requirements of the Charity Commission, bursaries are means-tested in accordance with the school's criteria which is available from the Bursar. Both parents are required to provide proof of their income and assets. For bursarial support to be considered it is expected that both parents make a financial contribution to fees. Bursaries are offered for twelve months at a time after which time the family is required to provide fresh information about its circumstances for every year that their child attends the school. Levels of support may vary with fluctuations in income.
