NB For all international pupils requiring sponsorship from Port Regis for the Child Student visa through the Points-Based Immigration System, a year's fees in advance are required whereby one term's fees is held as deposit for the final term's bill, and two further term's boarding fees are used for payment of the first two term's fees. Differential evidence requirements are in place for pupils from the EU, EEA and Switzerland with regards to financial evidence.

School fees cover costs that apply to all pupils including tuition, text books, meals and transport to school fixtures. Extra charges are made to cover costs specific to individuals or groups of pupils. The majority of these (other than examination fees) are non-compulsory. These include but are not limited to:

English as an Additional Language Tutoring Fee

Pupils for whom English is not the first language are charged an EAL Tutoring Fee linked to the level of support required at one of three levels:

- **Beginners** in English - £1000 per term (i.e. requiring 6-12 EAL lessons per week*)
- **Intermediate** English Speakers - £700 per term (i.e. requiring 2-4 EAL lessons per week*)
- **Fluent** English Speakers - £415 per term. (i.e. requiring language monitoring and 2 or fewer EAL lessons per week*)

New pupils normally start at the 'Beginner level' but parents will be advised if, after assessment, it becomes apparent that an alternative level is more appropriate. Individual lessons within the * EAL lessons are charged at £43.00 per 30 minute lesson individually, or £37.00 per 30 minute lesson in small groups in addition to the above Tutoring Fee.

Travel Service for Overseas Pupils

The school is able to provide assistance in making arrangements for pupils travelling to and from school at the beginning and end of term, half term and exeats. This includes arranging taxis to and from Port Regis, secure storage of passports and visas, holding e-tickets and visas, checking documentation, getting children ready at appropriate times and providing snacks on longer journeys. Direct costs of taxis, minibus journeys etc are charged in addition.

Purchase of Uniform

The School Uniform Shop is located here at school in Centenary Hall and is run by Direct Clothing. Parents may purchase all items at the shop, or order on line at: www.thedirectclothing.co.uk/school/port-regis-school. All items are paid for at the point of purchase to Direct Clothing.

Notes

- School fees are due and payable on or before the first day of term. A charge of 2% per month will be levied on the outstanding balance of all accounts not settled by the first day of term.
- Notice of withdrawal from the School must be received, in writing, by the Headmaster before the start of the preceding term. Failure to give adequate notice renders Parents liable for full fees, in lieu of notice, for the following term. Half a term's notice, in writing, is also required to discontinue music and Learning Support/Maths/Modern Language/EAL lessons or any other extra academic lesson if appropriate.
- Termly fees include Personal Accident Insurance. Parents are advised to take out their own insurance for loss or damage to personal effects.
- Additional charges will be made for such items as: breakages, Design & Technology project materials, entrance fees for senior school examinations, some extra-curricular activities, hairdressing, sheet music, school trips, expenses incurred at parental expense.
- There is a sibling discount of 10% on the above fees for the third and subsequent child concurrently studying at Port Regis.
- Fees may be paid in advance. Conditions apply and details are available from the Bursar's office.
